Codes of Conduct for Parents and Carers

As parents you are expected to:

- Positively reinforce your child and show an interest in their chosen activity.
- Do not place your child under pressure or push them into activities they do not want to do.
- Complete and return the Registration, Medical and Consent Form pertaining to your child's participation with Teach Me Kung Fu Schools (see parental consent).
- Deliver and collect your child punctually before and after sessions/events.
- Ensure your child has clothing and kit appropriate to the weather conditions
- Ensure that proper uniform and protective equipment are worn. Any child not in possession of the fundamental requirements will not be permitted to participate.
- Detail any relevant medical concerns or conditions pertaining to their child on the registration/consent form. Any changes in the state of the child's health should be reported to the instructor/school/event staff prior to the activity.
- To inform the organiser prior to the activity starting if your child is to be collected early.
- Encourage your child to follow the rules and teach them that they can only do their best.
- Ensure that your child understands their code of conduct.
- Behave responsibly on the side-line; do not embarrass your child.
- Show appreciation and support the instructor/school/event staff.
- Ensure your child is punctual.
- Be realistic and supportive.
- Ensure your child has appropriate equipment, plus adequate food and drink.
- Accept the instructor's judgment and do not enter the training area.
- Promote your child's participation in training martial arts.

As a parents/carer you have the right to:

- Be assured that your child is safeguarded during their participation.
- Be informed of problems or concerns relating to your children.
- Be informed if your child is injured.
- Have your consent sought for issue such as trips or photography.
- Have any concerns about any aspect of your child's welfare listened to responded to.

Any breaches of this code of conduct will be dealt with immediately by an instructor of Teach Me Kung Fu Schools. Persistent concerns or breaches may result in you being asked not to attend training if your attendance is considered detrimental to the welfare of young participants.

The ultimate action should a parent/guardian continue to breach the code of behaviour may be Teach Me Kung Fu Schools regrettably asking your child to leave the session or event.
